NAME

CURLINFO_STARTTRANSFER_TIME – get the time until the first byte is received

SYNOPSIS

```
#include <curl/curl.h>
```

```
CURLcode curl_easy_getinfo(CURL *handle, CURLINFO_STARTTRANSFER_TIME, double *timep);
```

DESCRIPTION

Pass a pointer to a double to receive the time, in seconds, it took from the start until the first byte is received by libcurl. This includes *CURLINFO_PRETRANSFER_TIME(3)* and also the time the server needs to calculate the result.
